

CRC Winter Handicap League
2011—2012

The CRC Board instructed me as match director of the Winter Handicap League to formalize and give clarity to the rules of the league. Below is the new format that will take effect on Wednesday, November, 9, 2011.

We have completed 4 weeks of the indoor season. All matches fired to date have been scored as Bullseye matches and entered into the “Bullseye” data base. All of these matches count toward the total of 13 for the award of ammunition at the end of the season. There is no change in the format of the “Revolver” matches.

The CRC Board has indicated they support the concept that the Winter Handicap League should be both enjoyable for competitors and provide them with options for competition based on different ability levels, shooting interests, and shooting equipment. Although the CRC Board wishes to maintain and encourage the course of fire required for an NRA Sanctioned Conventional Pistol (Bullseye) Match, all competitors will have the following options for matches and scoring:

A. Rim-Fire Competition:

- a. A shooter may shoot two (2) 300 point matches for \$3.00 and record his score in the “Rim-Fire” match column of the score sheet.
- b. A shooter may shoot three (3) 300 point matches for \$4.00 and record his best two 300 point matches in the “Rim-Fire” match column of the score sheet.
- c. Only rim-fire ammunition (.22 caliber) is to be shot during the Rim-Fire Competition.

B. Revolver Competition:

- a. A shooter shoots a 300 point match for \$1.00 and records his score in the “Revolver” match column of the score sheet.
- b. A shooter may choose to complete with any caliber revolver, with or without (non-magnified) optics.

C. Bullseye Competition:

- a. A shooter shoots a 600 point match for \$3.00 and records his score in the “Bullseye” match column of the score sheet.
- b. The course of fire for this competition is one (1) 300 point rim-fire (.22 caliber) match and one (1) 300 point center fire match.
- c. Shooting a third 300 point match, of any caliber, is not permitted in the Bullseye Competition.

D. Non-Member Fees:

- a. Non-members will pay a fee of \$1.00 in addition to the regular match fees.
- b. Non-members will be eligible for ammunition and classification awards.

E. Awards:

- a. Shooters who have completed a total of 13 matches in either the Rim-Fire Competition or the Bullseye Competition are eligible to receive one brick of rim-fire (.22 caliber) ammunition. A shooter may mix and match their chosen competitions to achieve ammo. See item (b) (3) below.
- b. The following criteria will be used for awards based on classification:
 1. Awards will be given for each competition: Rim-Fire, Revolver and Bullseye.
 2. The awards for each competition will include High Scratch Score, High Handicap Score, 1st Master, 1st Expert, 1st Sharpshooter, 1st Marksman and 1st Pro-Marksman.
 3. To qualify for an award in any competition, a shooter must have 13 matches in that competition.
 4. At the completion of the season, shooters who are eligible for class awards will have the option of receiving a trophy/plaque or accept the cash equivalent.
